All sentences must begin with a capital letter.

CL

Question Marks

A question mark is used to show that a question has been asked.

Have you eaten a good breakfast today?

Used to join two main clauses together.

Used to join a main clause and a subordinate clause.

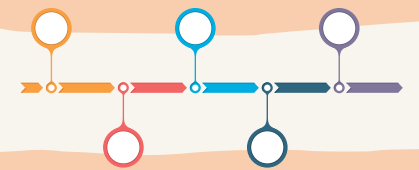
**if since as

Simple Past Tense

Describes events which happened at a specific time, but are now completed.

***I baked he baked
we baked***



Simple Present Tense

Describes something that happens regularly.

***I bake he bakes
we bake***
